ICD Changes for 2017

• Hallux Valgus/Bunion

- o 2016 terminology included bunion in the hallux valgus description
- **2017** separates the coding:
 - M20.1 Hallux Valgus
 - M21.611 Bunion of right foot
 - M21.612 Bunion of left foot
 - M21.619 Bunion of unspecified foot
 - M21.621 Bunionette of the right foot
 - M21.622 Bunionette of the left foot
 - M21.629 Bunionette of unspecified foot

• Laterality

- o Tarsal Tunnel Syndrome
 - 2016 G57.5 included right, left, and unspecified choices in coding
 - 2017 G57.53 denotes Tarsal Tunnel Syndrome, bilateral lower limbs
- o Plantar Nerve
 - 2017 G57.63 Lesion of plantar nerve, bilateral lower limbs
- o Causalgia
 - 2017 G57.73 Causalgia of bilateral lower limbs
- o Mononeuropathies
 - 2017 G57.83 Other specified mononeuropathies of bilateral lower limbs
 - 2017 G57.93 Unspecified mononeuropathy of bilateral lower limbs
- Disorders of the peripheral nervous system
 - o 2017 G61.82 Multifocal motor neuropathy
- Abnormal Glucose
 - o 2017 R73.03 prediabetes and latent
- Vascular deformity coding
 - 2016 I83.1 varicose veins of lower extremities with inflammation included stasis dermatitis
 - o **2017 I83.1** no longer contains stasis dermatitis
 - I87 other disorder of veins and I87.2 venous insufficiency (chronic) (peripheral) both now contain stasis dermatitis
- Foot Fracture Categories
 - 2017 S92 fracture of foot and toe, except ankle and S92 fracture of calcaneus both now *exclude* Physeal fracture of calcaneus (S99.0___)
 - 2017 S92.3 fracture of metatarsal bone(s) excludes physeal fracture of metatarsal (S99.1_)
 - 2017 S92.4 fracture of great toe excludes physeal fracture of phalynx of toe (S99.2_)

- 2017 S92.5 fracture of lesser toe(s) excludes physeal fracture of phalynx of toe (S99.2_)
- Sesamoid Fracture--new codes below would include sesamoid fracture of foot
 - **S92.8** Other fracture of foot, except ankle
 - **S92.81** Other fracture of foot
 - **S92.811** Other fracture of right foot
 - **S92.812** Other fracture of left foot
 - **S92.819** Other fracture of unspecified foot.
- New physeal subcategory of codes
 - begins with S99.00 (unspecified fracture of calcaneus) to S99.9 (unspecified injury of ankle and foot)
- Many definitions of codes have sight changes in the terminology of the "excludes" and "use additional" category
 - o gout
 - o diabetes mellitus
 - o gangrene
 - o acquired deformities of limbs
 - post procedural fever
 - o severe sepsis
