

Humana-Timely Filing Periods

The timely filing, otherwise referred to as proof of loss, period is the time-frame from the date of service until the date by which a claim must be submitted to Humana to receive reimbursement for rendered covered services.

Commercial Payment Policy In addition to the policy, claims payments are subject to other plan requirements for the processing and payment of claims, including, but not limited to, requirements of medical necessity and reasonableness and applicable referral or authorization requirements.

The standard timely filing period is 180 days from the date of services unless another standard, based upon applicable state mandate, provider contract or group contract, applies.
